- Watch children for signs of learning disabilities

# Construction Labourer

- Direct traffic at or near construction sites

On-the-job

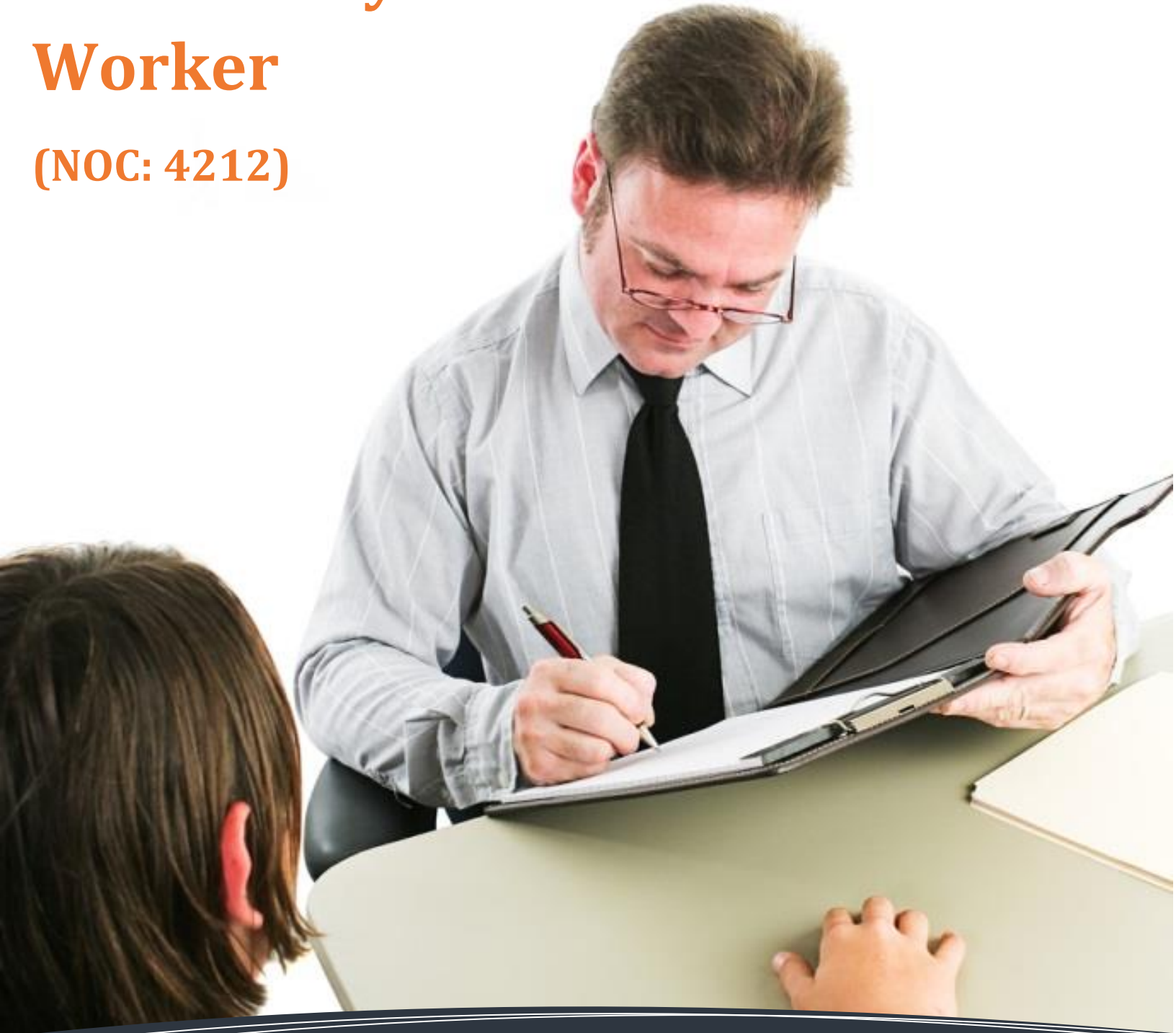
## Job duties may include
